Dear Friends and Family of Brooke,

I'm writing to let you know how Brooke's legacy is continuing in 2008.

Thanks to your support, the Brooke Forges Legacy Fund has \$1100 to disperse this year.

Last year, we worked with Pathways in the Regent Park area of Toronto to identify two interns who produced documentaries for the CBC program, Outfront.

This year, we're trying something a bit different. We're supporting a new program being run by Humber College in Metro Toronto. It's an after-school radio program for 8 students from the Rexdale/Jameston area. Humber is working with community groups such as LOVE (Leave Out Violence) to find the students. They're producing features for a radio program called Street Noise that is broadcast on Humber Radio.

The pilot for the program has been completed. Here's a photo of the students who participated and a short bit of audio they produced for the show.
